One dies, others injured as APC picks candidate for LG poll in Jigawa

ONE person was reportedly killed while several others sustained injuries in Miga Local Government Area of Jigawa State when crises broke out during a meeting of the All Progressives Congress (APC) to select party candidates for the forthcoming council polls.

Reports indicated that

the crisis started over the weekend when a committee was set up by the state branch of the party to select the party's chairmanship candidate for the local government area.

A party stalwart and member of the committee who does not want his name to be mentioned, said: "The disagreement started when all localities

outside Miga, the headquarters of Miga council area, insisted that the candidate must come from outside Miga town.

"The people of Miga town also insisted that the council's candidate must come from Miga."

He added that representatives of the area in the House of Representatives, House of Assembly and

the party council chairman were all from Miga.

When contacted, the APC chairman in the state, Alhaji Ado Sani Kiri, said: "It is normal to have disagreement in politics especially on issue of candidature."

Also contacted, the state Police Public Relations Officer, SP Abdul Jinjiri, confirmed the incident but said nobody died.
