

Auto crash claims 4 in Abuja

FOUR persons lost their lives at Dutse Alhaji in the Federal Capital Territory (FCT) in an accident involving cars and motorcycle operators.

Five others were also critically injured in the incident.

The accident occurred at Dutse-Alhaji junction, on Murtala Muhammed Expressway (Kubwa Road).

It was gathered that a

tipper had rammed into a Toyota Camry car which lost control and consequently crushed stationery commercial motorcycle operators besides the Public Service Institute on the expressway.

Nigerian Tribune confirmed that the injured persons were rushed to Kubwa General Hospital for medical attention.

FCT Minister, Musa Bello, confirmed the accident and commiserated with the

victims of the incident.

He prayed for the repose of the souls of the departed ones and for rapid recovery of the injured persons, while urging those that lost their loved ones to take the incident in good faith.

Bello warned that commercial motorcycles operation remained banned in all the nooks and crannies of the Federal Capital City and directed security agents to ensure full enforcement.
