
A bus conductor who allegedly picked the handbag of a commuter in Oshodi area of Lagos State has been exposed by the mobile close circuit monitor camera in Oshodi area of the state.

The incident, Metro commun gathered, occurred at Obot suspected Ndom community in Etinan Local Government Area, sources,

when the police stormed the community to arrest some suspected criminals.

According to security sources, trouble started

when a teenager, who was caught stealing edible cassava snacks, was beaten to death by angry youths of the community.



"When they beat him to death, his remains were taken to the next village and buried in a shallow grave in the bush. The incident was reported to the police, who later stormed the community for investigation and arrest of the suspects," the source explained.

The angry youths, it was learnt, resisted and forced the three policemen and a driver to retreat.

The police later reinforced with more men, including operatives of the Special Anti Robbery Squad (SARS), leading to a bloody clash.

In the shootout that followed, the gang leader, simply identified as Ubong Isaiah, former Chairman of Task Force on sale of stickers to truck drivers, was killed by the police, forcing the youth to go on a mob action against the police.

The gang, heavily-armed with sophisticated guns and charms, were said to have overpowered the policemen, killed two and severely injured one who ran to the palace of the vil-

He added that Ubon sisted arrest and orchis boys to confront police, but was shot in the process, leading the escalation of the obetween his boys and police.
