Confusion as repairer dies inside generator room in Ogun

A 24-year-old man, Toheeb Quadri, a generating set repairer, has been found dead in a controversial circumstance on Sunday inside the generator room of a residential building in Atoyo area of Sagamu, Ogun State.

Nigerian Tribune learnt that Quadri might have gone to repair his customer's generating set when the incident

happened.

The body of the deceased was discovered by members of his family after they had searched everywhere for him.

The owner of the property, one Kelechi (surname withheld) was almost lynched by a mob when he allegedly feigned ignorance of the incident.

He was alleged to have denied knowledge of ever knowing the deceased.

AUTHORITIES of the Nigeria Police, Osun State command, on Monday, in Osogbo, handed over a missing child_identified

accusing the pastors and worshippers on the mountain of kidnapping his son, contending that he only raised the alarm when he discovered that his son was missing. what Nigerian Tribune gathered, further aggravated the situation, as the suspect's house was vandalised by the mob.

The suspect was said to have reported the matter at a nearby police station.

He said that the circumstances surrounding the death of Quadri were unquestionable, saying that the matter had been transferred to the homicide section at the command headquarters, Eleweran, Abeokuta.
