## 5 graves found as police discover ritualists' shrine in Ikorodu

HE police in Lagos State on Monday discovered a shrine suspected, to be a hideout for criminals in Agbowa area of Ikorodu, while the owner of the shrine has been placed under investigations.

The discovery was reportedly made by a team

of policemen, led by the Deputy Commissioner of Police in charge of Operations at the state police command, Imohimi Edgal.

Though details of the findings at the shrine were yet to be made available to the public, it was gathered that the police, identified five suspected of land

were said to be old, a police source told Nigerian Tribune that there were signs that the fifth one was recently covered.

gathered that the police in the state were on a show of force against the resurgence of the Badoo cult group members in Ikorodu, when graves on the vast expanse they got a hint of the shrine.

Preliminary investigations by the police revealed that the shrine had more than five rooms with with heavy barricade at the entrance.

The police image-maker in the state, Olarinde Famous-Cole, confirmed the discovery, but quickly said that investigations were ongoing on it.
