

One dies in Ogun auto crash (2)

THE Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC), on Tuesday, confirmed the death of one person in an early morning accident that occurred on Owode-Ijoko Road, Sango-Ota in Ogun.

Mr Adekunle Oguntinyinbo, the Sango-Ota Unit Commander of FRSC, told the *News Agency of Nigeria (NAN)* in Ota that the accident occurred at about 2.00 a.m.

Oguntinyinbo said that the accident occurred when a DAF truck marked BDG 522 XS heading towards Abeokuta from Lagos lost control due to brake failure and rammed into another articu-

lated truck.

He said that three persons were involved in the accident, but ~~only one of them~~ died.

"The corpse of the deceased has been deposited at the Sango-Ota General Hospital," the FRSC official said.

The unit commander advised drivers to always maintain speed limits and ensure that their vehicles were road-worthy before embarking on a journey to avert road accidents.

Oguntinyinbo said that the vehicles had been towed from the scene of accident to prevent a gridlock on the road.
