Troops repel Boko Haram attack in Borno co

BODUNRIN KAYODE-MAIDUGURI WITH AGENCY REPORT

ROOPS of the Nigerian Army, on Wednesday, repelled an attack by the Boko Haram insurgents, at Mainok community in Kaga Local Government Area of Borno State.

The News Agency of Nigeria (NAN) learnt that the troops engaged the insurgents in gun battle at Mainok, about 73 kilometres drive from Maiduguri.

Mainok is one of the liberated communities rehabilitated by the government.

The town recorded high number of returnees due to the relative peace in the area.

The troops, according to witnesses, killed about 10 insurgents and wounded others when they tried to infiltrate a military unit in the town.

A former chairman of incident occurred at about the council, Alhaji Lawal Wasaram, confirmed the incident to NAN.
