Man remanded in prison for allegedly giving another man poison

A Kano State High Court, on Wednesday, remanded one Abubakar Ali (48), in prison for allegedly poisoning one Ibrahim Adamu to death.

Ali who lives in Rimin Kebbe Quarters, Kano, was arraigned on a two-count

(NAN), the prosecuting counsel, Mr Usman Abdullahi, told the court that on July 20, at about 3:00 p.m. the defendant mixed a juice drink with poison, while offering it to the deceased.

"The defendant gave the poisoned juice to Adamu, who had offered him a car ride from Gaya to Maradi in Niger Republic.

"Ali then robbed Adamu of his Peugeot 307 valued at N850,000, two bicycles valued at N20,000, one fridge valued at N17,000 and one carton of Macaroni valued at N2,000."
