How suspected armed bandit robbed, killed friend in Bauchi

A 40-year-old resident of Magaman-Gumau in Toro Local Government Area of Bauchi State, Suleiman Yunusa, has been sent to an early grave by a close friend who allegedly conspired with an armed robbery gang that launched an attack in his house and shot him dead.

It was gathered that Suleiman Yunusa's close friend, one Ahmadu Ngari, betrayed him when he conspired with armed bandits

who carried out the operation.

The Police Public Relations Officer of the State Command, DSP Kamal Datti Abubakar, in a statement made available to newsmen in Bauchi, on Tuesday, said two suspects had been arrested in connection with the killing of Yunusa.

The police spokesperson stated that "Abubakar Sadiq Mohammed (20) and Yahaya Mohammed (18) of Ladduga village, Toro LGA, were arrested in

connection with the killing of one Suleiman Yunusa.

"The two arrested suspects confessed to conspiring with one Ahmadu Ngari, a commercial motorcycle rider now at large, to commit the crime."

The PPRO also stated that, "the said Ngari happened to be very close and trusted by the late victim. He usually called Ngari whenever he needed the service of commercial motorcyclist but, unfortunately, he betrayed him by inviting his robbery gang

that attacked and killed him.

"The robbery incident was reported at Toro Police Station, that on December 28, 2017, at about 11:40p.m., unknown gunmen stormed the residence of one Sulaiman Yunusa (40) of Magama Gumau village, Toro LGA of Bauchi State, with an intention to rob.

"In the process, they stabbed and shot him. He was rushed to the General Hospital, Toro and later referred to ATBU Teaching Hospital, Bauchi but died on December 30 while receiving treatment for gunshot injuries."
