IT was the end of the road for three suspected armed robbers who had been making life unbearable for residents' of Mbiatok Itam in Itu Local e Fire Government Area of Akwa came Ibom State as they were burnt to death by irate mob.

learnt that the trio, who were chased and rounded up by vigilant youths of the area, were forced into drainage and set ablaze.

According to Chief Inyang Umoh, a community leader, while speaking to the **Nige**rian Tribune, "we live in terrible fear every night because of the criminal activities of these hoodlums.

"These people are very deadly; they steal, rape and kill innocent persons. If they are caught and handed over to the police, the next minute, they would return to engage in more bloody activities.'

In the same vein, Effiong Sampson, one of the local vigilance group members in the area, added that "the era of arresting criminals and handing them over to the police is over because the police would take bribe and release them."

The state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), DSP Odiko Macdon Ogbeche, confirmed the incident, but

He urged the people to ways liaise with law-enfor ment agencies for the law take its course through arrest and prosecution suspected criminals, wh denying that the police lease arrested criminals.

The PPRO, who lament the involvement of youths criminal activities, advis young people to engage meaningful ventures stead of taking to crimes.

"We have been advisi the youths to find son thing and do for a livi because crime does r pay. Imagine how they we burnt to death, even the parents and families do even know where they are Ogbeche said.

## in probe on gang rape at musician's concert in Enugu

A statement by the state Police Public Relations Officer, Ebere Amarizu, said: "the state command of the Nigeria Police Force through its operatives of the Independence Layout division have commenced a full-scale investigation into the alleged conduct of some people ranging from

attempt to gang-rape a victim as well as other offences.

Amarizu stated: "One person who is already helping the operatives in their investigations has been nabbed for his alleged role in the attempt to gang-rape a victim at Michael Okpara Square axis during a musical concert by a Nigerian popular musician.

"Also nabbed were three others in relations to alleged offences of snatching and stealing of handsets during the said event. Those arrested will be made to face the music in line with various provisions and specifications of

the law after a full-scale investigation," he said.

Reports had it that many youths openly smoke marijuana during the event, notwithstanding the presence of a large number of policemen and other security operatives who were deployed in the Okpara Square.
