



Teacher slumps, dies after playing football in Ebonyi school

A school teacher in Ebonyi State, Mr John Odah, died in the school premises shortly after playing football during students' sports period.

Nigerian Tribune gathered that Odah, a teacher at a secondary school in Ishielu Local Government Area, was hale and hearty on July 5, and even took part in supervising students in the ongoing third term examination.

In the evening of same day, he reportedly played football during the school's sports time.

Odah, however, slumped after the football match as he was going to the bathroom.

Nigerian Tribune further gathered that Odah, who taught Civic Education, lived within the school compound.

He was said to have re-

ceived some first aid treatment before he was rushed to the hospital.

The late teacher was a graduate of Mass Communication, and was almost through with his Masters' degree at the Nnamdi Azikiwe University, Akwa, Anambra State.
