2 dead as truck rams into fuel tanker, bus in Ogun

FEDERAL Road Safety Corps (FRSC), Sango-Ota, Ogun State command, on Thursday, confirmed that two persons died while some others sustained injuries in an accident that involved three vehicles on Ilo-Awela Road, Sango-Ota.

The Sango-Ota Unit Commander of FRSC, Mr Adekunle Oguntinyinbo, who confirmed the incident in an interview with the *News Agency of Nigeria (NAN)*, said that the accident occurred at about 9:45 p. m. on Wednesday.

Oguntinyinbo explained that a Mack truck with registration number LND 615XP that was heading to Lagos from Ilo-Awela road, lost control due to speed,

and rammed into a Mazda bus with registration number KSF 102XD and a tanker with registration number APP 273XP, in the process of crossing the road median.

He said that two out of 18 persons in the bus died while some others sustained injuries.

“The corpses of the victims have been deposited at the morgue of General Hospital, Ota, while those injured are receiving treatment at Leadway Hospital, Ota,” he said.

The unit commander advised motorists who were not familiar with the terrain of Sango-Ota and its environs to always drive carefully and ensure their vehicles were always in good condition.
