

Businessman dies in B kidnappers' den in Kogi, two suspects arrested

AN Ankpa, Kogi State-based businessman, Mr Sanni Aliu, kidnapped a few days ago, has died in the custody of his abductors, the police in the state confirmed, on Tuesday, to the **News Agency of Nigeria (NAN)** in a statement.

Aya said that Aliu's body was found by a combined team of police and Department of State Services (DSS) in the kidnappers'

den at Ankpa, adding that two suspects had been arrested in connection with the incident.

According to him, the body of the 53-year-old businessman had been recovered and taken to hospital for post-mortem examination.

Aya also said 11 different SIM cards, 29 pieces of fake US dollar notes, 23 fake Euro notes, seven mobile phones and seven ATM cards of different banks were recovered from the suspects.

According to the police image-maker, the suspects would be charged to court as soon as investigation into the matter was concluded.
