The command's spokesman, Mr Othman Abubakar, who did not name the communities involved in

the incident, said it began on Tuesday and resulted in the burning of houses.

He said that it was triggered when a community whose indigenes were missing found one of the missing persons dead and the other critically injured in a neighbouring community.

"They mobilised and went

for a reprisal, burning houses. The situation is now under control.

"No arrest has been made yet and the incident did not affect the flow of traf-

fic along the Yola-Numan-Gombe road as being speculated," Abubakar said.
