The Osun State Sector Commander of the FRSC, Mr Peter Oke, who confirmed the deaths, said the accident occurred around

However, there were unconfirmed reports that about 30 people died in the multiple accident, which occurred when the brake of an articulated vehicle heading towards Akure, the Ondo State capital, failed while approaching a police checkpoint and rammed into vehicles coming from the opposite direction.
