Six suspected killers of traditional ruler in Kaduna paraded by DSS

THE Department of State Services (DSS) in Kaduna State has paraded six suspects arrested in connection with the murder of a first class traditional ruler in the state, Agom Adara Maiwada Galadima.

It will be recalled that the late traditional ruler was abducted about two weeks ago alongside his wife, who was later released.

However, when a ransom of N6 million was paid to the kidnappers, he was still killed, while his body was found at Kateri, along the Abuja//Kaduna highway.

Addressing journalists on Wednesday, the state DSS director, Alhaji Mahmoud Ningi, said following the killing, the service began tracking the suspects, and the six were arrested at different locations in the state.

He said: "During preliminary interrogation, they made confessional statements about their involvement in the crime.

"The suspects are, Adamu Sani (36), who allegedly masterminded the abduction. Others are Adamu Saidu (25), Adamu Isya (20), Yusuf Bello (32), Dahiru Muhammad Bello (28) and Muhammad Aminu."

Ningi, who said the DSS would ensure the proper prosecution of the suspects, as well as intensify efforts to apprehend other members of the gang, thanked the military and other security agencies for their support during the operation.

s CP bans beer parlours in barracks

Provost Section to embark on tour of all police formations and barracks within the state with a view to identifying and shutting down all beer parlours within the police community.

The PPRO stated that the video of the drunk policeman got to the attention of the Inspector General of

Police, Ibrahim Idris, who ordered the state police commissioner to fish out the erring policeman for appropriate disciplinary action.

CSP Oti explained that after being identified, the policeman, an Inspector, was tried in orderly room and summarily dismissed to serve as a deterrent to others. The statement from the PPRO further read that: "In the same vein, the police commissioner, hereby, warns against offering policemen alcoholic drinks while on duty by members of the public. He added that henceforth, any policeman found drunk on duty will be visited with similar punishment.
