owner kills manager over N40,000 in Anambra

A manager at Nenco filling station in Nnewichi community in Nnewi North Local Government Area of Anambra State was, on Wednesday, killed allegedly by the owner of the station.

Nigerian Tribune gathered that problem started when the owner told the deceased to produce the N40,000 which he claimed was missing from the station's purse. It was gathered further

that the manager begged his employer to deduct the money from his November salary; but the employer declined, insisting that the money must be produced instantly.

What seemed like a drama turned bloody when the owner, in a move to recover the said money, allegedly stabbed his manager several times with a screwdriver, which led to his collapse.

The manager was rushed to a hospital along Oba Road in Nnewi, where doctors confirmed him dead.

The owner of the filling station immediately absconded from the hospital upon hearing that the manager had died.

The body of the deceased was later taken to an undisclosed destination by police operatives in Nnewi.

The state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Haruna Mohammed, confirmed the incident.

He, however, said the command was yet to get the full details of what led to the killing.
