

## Daughter allegedly hacks mother to death in Enugu

**E**NUGU State, Police Command has commenced investigation into the killing of a 58-year-old woman allegedly by her daughter, the *News Agency of Nigeria (NAN)* has reported. The command's spokesman, SP Ebere Amaraizu, said that the 34-year-old woman allegedly hacked her mother to death last Sunday following a dispute. Amaraizu said that the incident took place at Ifite village in Mmaku community of Awgu Local Government Area of the state.

He said police operatives were yet to establish what led to the incident.

"It was gathered that the incident occurred on that fateful day when the daughter of the woman, identified as Martina Anukwu, about 34 years,

inflicted several machete cuts all over the body of her mother, identified as Scholastica Anukwu, who was about 58 years.

"It was also gathered that following the cuts, the victim became unconscious and was later

confirmed dead," the police spokesman said in a statement.

He said that the suspect had been helping police operatives in their investigations, while the body of the deceased had been deposited at a morgue.



## Pastor who allegedly defiled friend's twin daughters remanded in prison
