3 die, 11 injured in Lagos/Ibadan expressway

The FRSC official said that the injured victims had been taken to Idera Hospital in Sagamu, while bodies of the three people, who lost their lives had been deposited at the morgue in Olabisi Onabanjo University Teaching Hospital (OOUTH), Sagamu.
