

Man allegedly stabs mother to death in Nasarawa

A 25-year-old, Michael Habila, has allegedly stabbed his mother to death in Tudun Gwandara community, in Lafia, the capital of Nasarawa State.

Habila was said to have attacked his mother for unknown reason in their family compound around 8:00 p.m , on Wednesday, after she had taken her bath.

The state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Ismaila Usman, who confirmed the incident, on Thursday, in Lafia, said, "It was on January 30, 2019 at 10:00 p.m. when our men who were on patrol were called upon to rescue one Michael Habila from the people after he had had a misunderstanding with his mother and stabbed her to death.

"Our men rushed her to a hospital where she later died while her son has been taken to B division."

According to the PPRO, investigation was ongoing to actually get to the root of the matter.

Information gathered by the **Nigerian Tribune**, however, revealed that Habila had for some time been harassing people in the community.
