300 Level UNIZIK student found dead in Anambra Commissioner's quarters

Deceased's eyeballs, underwear missing

The Nnamdi Azikiwe University (NAU) community in Akwa has been thrown into mourning following the tragic report of the death of one Miss Pauline, a 300 level student of the university whose body was allegedly dropped off from a vehicle by the roadside inside Commissioners' quarters.

The body of Miss Pauline, a Linguistics student of the university, was said to have been discovered in the area on Thursday evening.

However, as of the time of filing this report, the police said the actual cause of her death had

not yet been known.

It was gathered that the deceased's corpse had been taken to the mogue.

A resident of the area who preferred anonymity, told Saturday Tribune that the lady was found dead at a junction close to Demonstration Primary and Secondary School, Commissioners Quarters, Awka without her underwear and with her two eyes removed.

According to him, the killings of young girls, mostly students of the Nnamdi AzikiweUniversity, have become rampant.

The Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO) Anambra State Command,

SP Mohammed Haruna, who confirmed the incident to journalists in Awka in a telephone interview,

said investigation was ongoing to ascertain circumstances surrounding her killing.
