Man allegedly kills one, injures another during plan to steal motorcycle in Bauchi

A 33-year-old man, Mohammed Bako, allegedly killed one person and injured another in the early hours of Tuesday during the celebration of the electoral victory of the Peoples Democratic Party (PDP) governorship

candidate in Bauchi State, as he made an attempt to steal a motorcycle.

The incident was confirmed by the Bauchi State Police Command, as it disclosed that the injured person was undergoing treatment in the hospital.

The command's Public Re-

lations Officer, Kamal Datti Abubakar, said that the suspect was arrested by operatives of the Yelwa Divisional Police Headquarters in the early hours of Tuesday following a report of the killing.

Abubakar explained that the suspect, a resident of

Yelwan Makaranta, Bauchi, attempted to steal a motorcycle, but the people of the area raised the alarm, and he took to his heels.

The PPRO said: "People chased him and, in the process, he brought out a knife and stabbed Nasiri Hassan, 37, of Yelwan Makaranta and

Sadiq Adamu, 26, of Gwal-lameji."

The police spokesman, a Deputy Superintendent of Police (DSP), disclosed that the two victims were rushed to the Abubakar Tafawa Balewa University Teaching Hospital (ATBUTH), Bauchi, for treatment but said "un-

fortunately, Hassan died while receiving treatment while Adamu is receiving treatment at the same hospital."

The PPRO said that the case was under investigation, after which the suspect would be charged to court for prosecution.
