AN Ilorin High Court presided over by Justice Durosinlohun Kawu, has sentenced a 21-year- old man, Shefiu Abubakar, to 10 years imprisonment for killing his brother, Babuga Abubakar with burning firewood.

The incident happened in Dona Dogo, Edu local government area of Kwara State.

Abubakar committed the crime on suspicion that Babuga was having illicit affairs with his wife.

In his judgment, Justice Kawu stated that sometimes in 2015, the convict went to his elder brother's house after reporting at the police that he was dating his wife.

The trial judge added that Abubakar called his brother out from his house and hit him on the head with a wood which resulted in his death on the spot.
