

Police arrest alleged killer of Lagos NANS spokesperson

THE police in Lagos State have arrested the alleged killer of the spokesperson of the National Association of Nigerian Students (NANS) in the state, Aderibigbe Oshin-Adisa.

Oshin-Adisa died at the weekend following complications from a knife injury he sustained during an attack on him at Okokomaiko area of Lagos State on Thursday.

The police image-maker

in the state, DSP Bala Elkana confirmed the death to the *Nigerian Tribune* and added that one person has been arrested.

Oshin-Adisa just graduated from the Federal College of Fisheries and Marine Technology, Lagos, and was until

his death the Public Relations Officer of the Lagos State Joint Campus Committee of NANS.

Nigerian Tribune gathered that the NANS official was attacked by some hoodlums around Okokomaiko last Thursday.

He was stabbed and was quickly rushed to the hospital by his friends and residents of the area, but died on Friday following complications from the wounds.

Elkana, while confirming the incident to the *Nigerian Tribune*, identified the sus-

pect as Bashiru Ahmed a.k.a. Kawu as the one behind the murder of the NANS official.

He also added that the suspect had confessed to stabbing Oshin-Adisa and added that he would be charged to court as soon as investigations had been concluded.
