Man stabbed to death during disagreement at Lagos bar

A 37-year-old man has been stabbed to death during a clash at a drink joint at Dopemu area of Agege, Lagos State.

Police Public Relations Officer in the state, DSP Bala Elkana confirmed the killing, which occurred on Saturday, to the *Nigerian Tribune*, and said that one person had been arrested.

Nigerian Tribune gathered that the deceased, identified as Bukola Oluwaseun, a resident of Adeyola Street, Dopemu, had gone to a bar on Ogunbambi Street where he was killed.

An argument reportedly ensued, which led to disagreement between two groups of people at the bar, when a man, identified as Sunday Isiah, stabbed

Oluwaseun with a broken bottle.

Elkana, while confirming the incident, said that about 2:45p.m. on the fateful day, Dopemu police station received a distress call that some persons engaged themselves in a fight at a drink joint on Ogunbambi Street, Agege.

He continued: "A team of policemen was drafted to the scene to restore order. Preliminary investigation carried out revealed that one Bukola Oluwaseun, 37 years old, of Adeyola Street, Dopemu was stabbed on the neck with a bottle by one Sunday Isiah (42).

"The victim died on the way to hospital and his corpse was deposited at the mortuary for post-mortem examination.

"The suspect has been arrested by the police. Investigation is ongoing. Case will be charged to court."
