Community members attack bandits at emir's palace in Zamfara, kill seven

MEMBERS of Birnin Magaji community in Zamfara State have killed seven suspected bandits who had gone to the emir's palace to strike a deal on how to take some cattle they rustled but which were recovered and kept at the emir's palace.

Nigerian Tribune gathered that the bandits had earlier rustled some cows in the areas, but were intercepted by operatives of the military, who then took the cattle to the emir's palace.

The bandits were, therefore, at the palace to see how the rustled cattle could be released to them.

According to a source who didn't want his name in print, the mob action might not be unconnected with the abduction of a residence of the community, who the bandits collected N2.5 million from members of his family as ransom but refused to release him.
