

## Police parade second suspect in murder of community leader in Anambra

**A**NAMBRA State Commissioner for Police, Mustapha Dandaura on Monday paraded Okoye-Ernest Chinwe a.k.a. IBB, the second suspect allegedly connected with the murder of former

state lawmaker and the President General of Nimo Community in Njikoka Local Government Area of Anambra State, Chief Frank Anthony Igboka.

The Commissioner made the disclosure while addressing journalists on the progress made so far in respect of the murder which

took place on April 17. According to Dandaura, the Command's Special Anti-Robbery Squad (SARS) on May 3, at about 7:30p.m., arrested the second suspect one from Obosi in Idemili North Local Government Area of the state.

The police commissioner stated that the suspect was

initially covered, but later mentioned by the first suspect following discreet investigation.

He said the suspect was traced to his hideout at old INEC road, Awka and arrested.

"Upon interrogation, he confessed to being among the gang members that shot

and killed the President General, and is assisting the police with useful information that could lead to unravelling the circumstances that led to the incident, with the aim of arresting other fleeing accomplices," he stated.

The command had earlier, about a week ago, paraded one of the kingpins, Chigbo

Aneigbu, who allegedly actively participated in the killing; and declared three others wanted.

"I want to assure Ndi Anambra that the Command under my watch will not relent in its efforts until it gets all the remaining perpetrators apprehended and bring them to justice.
