Man who stabbed drunk friend to death in police net in Ogun

A 28-year-old man, Oni Olohunwa has been arrested by men of Ogun State Police Command for alleged stabbing his friend, Baraka Taiwo to death over a little disagreement.

It was gathered that the suspect was arrested on Sunday, May 5 following a report by one Wasiu Raheem, who took the victim to Ogijo Police Station, that

the suspect and the victim both attended a party, but the victim got drunk and started misbehaving.

The complainant stated that while the suspect was trying to caution him, an argument ensued between the two and the suspect brought out a knife with which he stabbed the deceased in the chest and back.

On the strength of the report, the Divisional Police

Officer, Ogijo Division, CSP Baba Mohammed quickly detailed his detectives to the scene and the suspect was promptly arrested.

Taiwo was said to have been rushed to a nearby hospital but died while receiving treatment, according to the police spokesman in the state, DSP Abimbola Oyeyemi in a statement issued by him.

The PPRO said that the victim's corpse had been

deposited at the Olabisi Onabanjo University Teaching Hospital (OOUTH), Sagamu for post-mortem examination. CC

He added that the state Commissioner of Police, Bashir Makama had ordered the immediate transfer of the suspect to homicide section of the State Criminal Investigation and Intelligence Department for further investigation and subsequent prosecution.
