Troops ambush, kill terrorists in Yobe

on Wednesday, killed a number of terrorists during an ambush, after the insurgents attempted to attack a military location at Gonori in Yobe State.

According to the News Agency of Nigeria (NAN), army spokesman, Colonel Sagir Musa, confirmed the incident in a statement on Thursday, saying that the terrorists came for the aborted attack in seven trucks and motorcycles.

Colonel Musa said troops seized five of the gun trucks, one Vehicle Blind Leger, quantity of ammunition and destroyed a number of motorcycles.

Meanwhile, the Chief of Army Staff, Lieutenant-Gen-

eral Tukur Buratai, who had been in the Command and Control Centre, commended the troops for the successes being recorded in recent times, while urging them to sustain the tempo of operation.

Buratai charged them to be more vigilant and assured them of continuous support.
