Suspected herdsmen kill septugenarian farmer in Ogun

herdsmen, on Sunday, stabbed to death a 76-year-old farmer, identified as Rafiu Sowemimo, at Adao in Alabata area of Ogun State.

The incident, according to information gathered by the Nigerian Tribune, occurred around noon, when the deceased was reported to be returning from his farm.

It was learnt that the farmer had escaped death by the whiskers some days ago as the suspected herdsmen attacked him with matchet on his head.

The incident, it was learnt, had thrown the entire community into confusion as youths in the area were said to be battle ready.

The Olu of Alabata, Chief Waheed Sanusi, confirmed the development and called on the state government to beef up security within and around the community, to any reprisal.
