Police nab two in Anambra for allegedly killing 24-year-old man over girlfriend

Okoye, over girlfriend.

According to the Command spokesman, SP Haruna Mohammed, who confirmed the arrest in a release in Awka, on Friday said;"On the Thursday, July 2019, at about 7:00a.m., following intelligence report, police detectives attached to Ogidi Division arrested one Dabem Okeke, aged 28 years and Okechukwu Okafo, aged 37 years both of Ogidi Aniuku Village in Idemili North LGA of Anambra State.

He stated that the suspects stormed the house of one Ifenyichukwu Kamsisichukwu, aged about 20 years, forced her to open her door and took away her boy friend, one Chinedu Okoye, aged 24 years of Umuru village, Ogidi and shot him with a gun.

"The victim sustained a gunshot injury on the back and was rushed to Twinkle Hospital, Ogidi for medical attention where he died while receiving treatment.

His corpse, he stated has been deposited at lyienu Hospital morgue, Ogidi for autopsy. According to Mohammed, investigation revealed that the principal suspect, Dabem Okoye, who allegedly pulled the trigger was suspected to be holding a grudge against the deceased over girl friend.

Meanwhile, the onesingle barrel gun allegedly used in perpetrating the act has been recovered from the suspects as exhibit. The suspects according to him would be charged to court later.
