

38-yr-old tenant, friend kill landlord over car

2 A 38-year-old suspect, Daniel Isaac, who allegedly murdered his landlord and dumped his body in a well, has been arrested by the police in Lagos State.

Also arrested alongside the tenant was his friend, Emmanuel Chukwu, who was also accused of being an accomplice in the incident.

The police image maker in the state, DSP Bala Elkana, confirmed the incident and added that the suspect made away with the victim's car.

It was gathered that the accomplice, Chukwu, was taking the car away when he was arrested by policemen at First Gate area of Iba town.

The deceased, Don Able, was until the incident the owner of one of the buildings situated on Owodun Street, Ikotun, where Isaac was a resident.

Elkana said: "On Wednesday, July 24, at about 5:00 a.m., policemen from Iba Division, who were on a stop-and-search duty at First Gate, Agboroko area, Iba, flagged down a **Toyota Camry** which was driven in a reckless and suspicious manner.

as "The two occupiers of the vehicle were arrested immediately. During Investigation by the police, it was revealed that Isaac had killed his landlord and dumped his corpse in a well inside his compound at Owodun Street Area, Ikotun.
