Police investigate alleged killing by policeman in Lagos

THE police command in Lagos State has begun investigation into the alleged killing of a man at Shogunle area of the state by a yet-to-be-identified mobile policeman.

Spokesman for the command, DSP Bala Elkanā, told

the *News Agency of Nigeria (NAN)* on Monday that the command had received the news of the killing.

Elkanā said the command was already investigating the identity of the policeman, the victim and what led to the in-

cident.

"We are investigating the case. I am gathering information for an update on the matter before going to the press," he said.

NAN reported that a stray bullet from an unidentified policeman allegedly killed one

Waliu Dauda on Sunday night at Shogunle area of Lagos.

It also learnt that the deceased was into chair renting business, but met his untimely death when he went to pack the chairs he rented out to a church at about 8:00 p.m.
