I brought my friends to my brother's house to collect money, but they killed him —Suspect

EKITI State police command has arrested one Ebenezer Olorunleke over the alleged killing of his brother, Sunday Olorunleke, in Ado-Ekiti, the state capital.

Nigerian Tribune had reported penultimate weekthat Ebenezer (24) from Kogl State, allegedly stabbed his brother to death at Abe Koko, Oke-IIa area of the state capital.

The deceased, a father of two, was a commercial motorcyclist, popularly called Okada.

Addressing journalists in Ado Ekiti on Tuesday, the state Commissioner of Police, Asuquo Amba said that the suspect stabbed his brother with a knife and a long screw driver on August 29, before fleeing the area.

The police commissioner

said the suspect and three others invaded his brother's home and stole his *Bajaj* motorcycle with registration number ADK 100 UJ after killing him.

"They hit him in the stomach and pierced his intestine when his wife and children were not at home. He has confessed to have committed the offence," Amba said.

Recounting how his brother was killed, Olorunleke said

what his friends wanted to do was to help him collect money from him, describing his brother as a stingy individual.

Ebenezer said: "I told my friends that I needed money to travel to my home state because I was tired of this state. They suggested I should go and meet my brother, but I told them he was stingy. They promised to help collect money from him

and we went to his house.

"I did not follow them inside the room, but upon realising that my brother had been stabbed and was shouting, I rushed in and wanted to rescue him but he bit me and chopped off my finger.

"The guys later came to my house to attack me. They wanted to sell the motorcycle, but I resisted. I was thinking of coming to the police to report when I was arrested." vent dise Ac
