## Suspected hotel worker's killer nabbed in Lagos

A member of a suspected gang at Obalende area of Lagos State who killed a worker at a popular hotel in the area, has been arrested by the police.

The deceased hotel worker,

Samuel Ladejo, on his way to a social function, on October 1, 2018, attacked and stabbed in the chest by a gang of hoodlums.

The state's police image-maker, DSP Bala Elkana, while confirming the arrest of the suspect to the *Nigerian Tribune*,

said that the police were on the trail of other members of the gang.

The police had earlier arrested a member of the deadly gang and were on the trail of others when another member of the gang was arrested.

Elkana said: "On September 12, at about 4:15p.m., following a sustained monitoring, one Kehinde Bakare, aged 23, a prime suspect in connection with the murder of one Samuel Ladejo, was arrested at Obalende, and a locally-made pistol with

two live cartridges was recovered from him."

The police spokesperson recalled that on October 1, 2018, at about 6:00 a.m., one Bisi Komolafe, an assistant manager of a popular hotel situated at 36, Obalende Road, Ikoyi reported at the

station that one of their staff members, Samuel Ladejo left the hotel to attend party on Obalende Road, Ikoyi where he was stabbed in the chest by some boys, currently at large, while he was rushed to a general hospital for treatment.
