3 die, 3 injured in Jos collapsed building

ANOTHER building collapsed in Jos, Plateau State, on Monday, killing three persons and injuring three others.

The latest development followed the recent collapse of a building in Jos North Local Government Area of the state, which claimed 14 lives.

Nigerian Tribune learnt that the latest incident occurred at about 11:45 p.m during a heavy down pour at Layin Yankoba in Angwan Rogo area of the state capital.

A source close to the scene of the incident said that there were six people in the building and adding that three of them, who were of

the same parents, died before they could be evacuated from the building. Another three occupants sustained various degrees of injuries and are receiving treatment at the Plateau State Specialist Hospital.

While narrating how the incident happened, the source said during the rain, an uncompleted building on

a hill top was washed away, and it landed on the building, which was just beneath the hill, thereby making it to collapse.

The state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), DSP Mathias Terna Tyopev, confirmed that three people died in the collapsed building, while three others sustained injuries.
