TRACE hires local divers to recover bodies of accident victims in Ogun

THE Ogun State Traffic Compliance and Enforcement Corps (TRACE) said it has hired local divers to complement the efforts of its personnel in recovering the bodies of some passengers inside a bus that plunged into Ososa River on Wednesday.

TRACE commander, Mr Seni Ogunyemi, made this known in an interview with the **News Agency of Nigeria (NAN)** in Ota on Thursday.

Ogunyemi said a commercial Sienna bus with 10 passengers heading to Ijebu-Ode from Sagamu plunged into the

Ososa River due to wrongful overtaking around 4.30 p.m.

He said that TRACE employed local divers to assist in the search for the bodies of victims after all efforts by its operatives from Ijebu-Ode division yielded no result.

He said: "We needed to hire

the local divers to engage in the rescue exercise because all efforts by our operatives yielded no result.

"TRACE operatives and local divers will not stop the rescue exercise until all the bodies in the ill-fated accident were found."
