Farmers, herdsmen clash claims three in Jigawa

hree people have been reportedly killed with six others injured after a clash between farmers and herdsmen in Jigawa State

The Commissioner of Police in the state, Mr Bala Zama, confirmed this to reporters on Tuesday in his office at the Police Command Headquarters in Dutse, the state capital.

According to him, the three persons were killed in separate clashes in Guri, Kirikasamma and Kiyawa lo-

cal government areas of the state.

Zama added that scores of policemen had been deployed in Birniwa Local Government Area following tension in the area.

He explained that the command got the information that some herders trooped into the town at harvest time.

The police commissioner, however, assured that the command was committed to ensuring the security of the lives and property of residents of the state.
