Man in police net for killing neighbour whose cattle destroyed his farm

THE Police in Niger State have arrested one Mohammed Isa, 27, of Dogon Ruwa village of Bosso Local Government Area of the state for allegedly and killing his neighbour, Umaru Abubakar, 30, with a dane gun.

The Commissioner of Police in the state, Usman Adamu, disclosed to News Agency of Nigeria (NAN) in Minna, on Saturday.

Adamu said that on December 5 at about 6:30pm hours the cattle of Umaru Abubakar, a cattle rearer and Fulani by tribe, entered

and caused destruction in the farm of the suspect, a Gwari by tribe.

He said Isa shot the cattle rearer at the farm.

"The victim was rushed to Minna General Hospital where he was confirmed dead by medical personnel on duty," he said.

The commissioner said the police command had already begun investigation into the matter after which the suspect would be charged to court.

He warned people against taking the law into their hands.
