One dies on Lagos/Ibadan expressway auto crash

THE Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC), Ogun State command, on Sunday, confirmed the death of one person following an accident that involved a truck and a Bajaj motorcycle around Nipco Petrol Station on the Lagos-Ibadan highway.

The state FRSC sector

commander, Mr Clement Oladele, disclosed this while speaking with the **News Agency of Nigeria (NAN)** in Ota.

Oladele said that the accident occurred at about 4.20 p.m., on Saturday.

He explained that a truck with registration number

DLA 540 XA, lost control due to over speeding and rammed into a Bajaj motorcycle which was driving against traffic.

Oladele said the accident resulted in the death of one of the passengers on the motorcycle.

"The corpse of the vic-

tim has been deposited at Fakoya Hospital, Sagamu," he said.

The sector commander, therefore, advised motorists and other road users to be careful and refrain from acts that could lead to unnecessary loss of lives and property.
