One dead, 4 injured in multiple accident on Abeokuta-Lagos expressway

THE Ogun State command of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC), on Tuesday, said that one person died in a multiple accident at the former toll gate on the Abeokuta-Lagos expressway.

The state FRSC sector commander, Clement Oladele, told the News Agency of Nigeria (NAN) in Ota that four others, comprising a woman and three men, who were also involved in the accident which occurred at 3:45 a.m., sustained various degrees of injuries.

He said: "The corpse of the male victim has been deposited at the mortuary of the State Hospital, Ota, Ogun, while the survivors are also receiving treatment at the same hospital."

Oladele said that a Mack truck, with registration number: AGL 676 CV, heading towards Lagos from Sango-Ota, three buses and three motorcycles were involved in the accident.

Oladele explained that the articulated vehicle lost control due to break failure and rammed into three Volkswagen LT buses and three motorcycles.
