Suspected Herdsmen Kill Security Man In Ondo

A member of a vigilante group in Ondo town, in Ondo East Local Government Area of Ondo State, Mr Kasali Ajeigbe, was allegedly killed by suspected Fulani herdsmen.

The 58 -year- old security man was said to have been hacked to death by his assailants while returning home from his place of work.

According to the brother of the deceased, Saheed Ajeigbe, who explained that the deceased was overpowered by the herdsmen who killed him by slitting his throat with knives.

He said his brother was waiting for a taxi after closing from the sawmill where he was working when the Fulani herdsmen attacked him.

He said: "My late brother went to his duty post and when he was returning home and waiting for a taxi by the road, he was attacked.

"Some Fulani men who were being chased by some policemen from Oke-Igbo where they went to rob attacked him and slit his neck with their knife.

"Policemen came and rushed him to the hospital where he was confirmed dead and his body deposited at the mortuary."

Confirming the incident, the Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Mr Tee-Leo Ikoro, said the command had commenced an investigation into the matter but said there was no proof that man was killed by the herdsmen.

He, however, assured that the command would soon bring the perpetrators of the crime to book.
