5 die in Abuja, Delta road crashes

TWO women died while three others were injured in an auto crash accident that occurred in Ogwashi-Uku area of Delta State on Saturday.

Sunday Tribune gathered that a Camry car with registration number AS-

B,635,AT said to be driven by a young man identified as Uche at about 7 a.m lost control and crashed into pedestrians near a reser-

voir. According to an eye witness, the driver was on top speed as he was headed towards Umudei axis when he lost control and crashed

into the pedestrians.

"One of the women who died on the spot was identified as Helen Odogwu, a staff of the state's judiciary.

Commissioner of Police in the state, Hafiz Inuwa, when contacted said he was yet to be briefed.

In a related development,

another auto accident claimed the lives of three persons on Saturday with seven others sustaining injuries.

According to the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC), the accident, which occurred on the Gwagwalada-Kwali Road in the Federal Capital Territory (FCT)

involved a trailer.

The Corps Public Relations Officer (PRO), Mr Bisi Kazeem, who confirmed the incident, said it happened at about 8:50 a.m. at Wazobia Park.

According to Kazeem, "at about 8:50 a.m, a trailer fully loaded with cows lost control at Gwagwal-

ada road while heading towards Kwali."

According to him, "male adults were injured while two female adults and one male adult confirmed dead."

He said the injured persons were later taken to Abuja University Teaching Hospital for treatment.
