

Rangers' Ifeanyi George killed in car crash

NIGERIA International and Enugu Rangers striker Ifeanyi George has died in a car accident at 11pm on Sept 17.

His death was confirmed by the Nigerian Football Federation (NFF) on Monday. George was on his way to Lagos after Rangers' 10-day break following the suspension of the NFF due to the outbreak of COVID-19.

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According to patchy information available to the management, our attacking sensation, Ifeanyi George who was in his vehicle driven by his friend including a 19 team player, had the vehicle involved in a parked accident while along Oshodi Agbol Road road, Sunday morning.
