77-yr-old girl found dead inside vehicle in Ekiti

A seven-year-old girl identified as Taiwo Olagoke, has been found dead in a vehicle parked within her parent's compound in Ado-Ekiti, the Ekiti state capital.

Nigerian Tribune gathered that the incident happened on Wednesday at Winners Avenue, in Olujoda area of the state capital.

A family source who spoke with the Nigerian Tribune explained that the deceased got missing at about noon and her body was later found in the evening in a vehicle parked in the compound.

The source added that a mechanic was seen working on the said vehicle before he left the compound at about 5:00 p.m.

She said: "Around 12 noon on Wednesday, the girls, who are twin sisters, wanted to go out to buy something on the street but Kenny remembered that she forgot her o money upstairs, so she went back to pick the money.

> "After she returned, she discovered that her twin sister was missing. People in the house started searching for

her until around 5:30 p.m. when her body was found peeled off in a vehicle inside the compound.

"But there was one man, a mechanic, working on the same vehicle and only left the place around 5:00 p.m."

The incident, according to the source, had been reported at the Ologede divisional police station in Ado-Ekiti.

When contacted, the state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Sunday Abutu, confirmed the incident, adding that the body had been deposited at a morgue.

Abutu said: "At about 3:00 p.m. yesterday (Wednesday), a case of missing child of about six years was reported in one of our divisional police headquarters here in Ado-Ekiti, that is, Ologede division.

"All efforts made to find the missing girl proved abortive, not until around 8:00 p.m. when she was found lifeless inside one of the cars parked in a mechanic workshop beside their house."

The PPRO added that the command had commenced investigation to unravel the cause of the death.
