2 persons murdered in Osun community

Police arrest one suspect

THERE was tension in Ejigbo community in Ejigbo Local Government Area of Osun State last Sunday and on Wednesday following the murder of two persons in the town.

A source informed the **Nigerian Tribune** that the first person who was murdered on Sunday was 45-year-old Misratu Azeez.

The discovery of her body inside a compound in the area was reported to the police around 10.30 a.m.

When police detectives visited the scene, the victim's head was suspected to have been broken by her assailants with a hard substance.

Detectives later moved her body to the mortuary for autopsy, while a suspect was arrested in connection with

the murder.

The case has been transferred to the State Criminal Investigation Department (SCID), Osogbo.

Similarly, another person, identified as Musibau Muraina, was also murdered on Wednesday inside his residence at Oya's compound, Ejigbo.

When the police visited the scene, the stomach of the

victim was lacerated, thereby making his intestines to gush out.

When contacted on Thursday, the state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Mrs Yemisi Opalola, confirmed the incidents.

She said the state Commissioner of Police, Mr Undie Adie, had ordered thorough investigation into the killings.
