2 burnt to death in Niger auto crash

TWO persons were burnt beyond recognition while several others sustained various degrees of injury following an accident involving three vehicles in Niger State on Wednesday.

The incident, which occurred at Bonu Community in Gurara Local Government Area of the state, on the Lambata-Minna highway, involved a petrol-laden tanker,

an 18-seater bus on the fleet of the Niger State Transport Authority (NSTA) and a Mazda 323 car.

The impact of the accident made the tanker go up in flames, with the fire affecting the other vehicles.

Those who sustained serious burns were rushed to the Federal Medical Centre, Gawu Babangida, for medical attention by personnel of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC).
