

Man shot dead over Shawarma in Lagos, bar owner, 5 others arrested

SIX people, including the owner of a popular bar in Alagbado area of Lagos State, have been arrested in connection with the death of a guest who was shot dead over the weekend.

The deceased, 35-year-old Kayode Oloruntoba, was shot by a yet-to-be-identified customer who had come to the bar to buy 'Shawarma.'

The state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), SP Muyiwa Adejobi, confirmed the incident and the arrest

of the suspects to the *Nigerian Tribune* in a statement signed by him on Monday.

Adejobi also said that a friend to the deceased, who failed to report the incident to the police but took the victim to a herbalist for treatment, has also been arrested.

Adejobi said: "The Lagos State police command has arrested six suspects who have questions to answer for the shooting and killing of one Kayode Oloruntoba, (35) on Friday, September 11, at Alagbado area of Lagos State."
