

Assailants attack Bauchi community, kill 2

YET-to-be identified assailants on Saturday invaded Gudum Hausawa, a suburb of Bauchi metropolis, and killed two persons.

Nigerian Tribune gathered on Sunday that the assailants, numbering more than 10, invaded the community in commando-like manner and shot sporadically.

At the end of their mission, two persons, a man and a young girl, were found dead.

A resident of the community who spoke with the **Nigerian Tribune** on the condition of anonymity, said no one could ascertain the reason for the attack on the community.

He, however, said that there was a minor misunderstanding among some people in the community recently, but no one could say if the invasion was linked to the issue.

The state's Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), DSP Wakili Ahmed, confirmed receiving information on the killings.

He, however, added that investigation had commenced to apprehend the killers.

The police spokesperson said the Commissioner of Police, Lawan Tanko Jimeta, had drafted police personnel to the area in order to maintain law and order and curtail any reprisal
