Protesters clash with hoodlums in Kano, 2 feared killed, 7 vehicles burnt Nobody died — Police

TWO girls were feared killed on Tuesday when EndSARS protesters were attacked by hoodlums who brandished dangerous weapons at Sabongari area in Kano.

During the attack, seven vehicles were burnt, while eight others were damaged.

The popular mall, located at Aba Road, and a hotel along Hausawa Road were also vandalised, while goods in the mall were looted.

However, before the attack, the protesters had assembled along Sarkiyarki, by Court Road in preparation for the protest but were dispersed by security operatives.

They later regrouped

and went through Freetown to Court Road, where they were accosted by the hoodlums who brandished dangerous weapons.

A source among the protesters who preferred anonymity told newsmen that during the confrontation with the hoodlums, two girls among the protesters were killed by the hoodlums.

However, the state's Commissioner of Police, Habu Sani, while speaking with pressmen on the incident, said nobody was killed during the clash.

Sani, however, confirmed that seven vehicles were burnt, while a medical doctor was arrested for being in possession of a gun and ammunition.
